


Common Name: Basil, Cinnamon

Botanical Name: *Ocimum basilicum* 'Cinnamon'



- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 26 – 30 in.
- **Width:** 12 in.
- **Habit:** Upright
- **Flower:** Reddish-purple
- **Bloom Season:** Mid to late summer
- **Foliage:** Tiny leaves & tight, fine-textured form
- **Flavor:** Rich spiciness
- **Fragrance:** Pungent cinnamon
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Resistant:** Resist going to seed
- **Attracts:** Butterflies, bees 
- **Uses:** Great in containers, border, cut foliage, baked goods, flavored honey, fruit salad, apple cider, poaching liquid for pears & peaches
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, including removal of flower stalks, encourages new leaf growth, more branching & discourages flowering..
