

Common Name: Basil, Greek Columnar

Botanical Name: *Ocimum basilicum* 'Greek Columnar'



- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 24 – 36 in.
- **Width:** 9 - 12 in.
- **Habit:** Columnar
- **Flower:** NA
- **Bloom Season:** Late bloom if at all
- **Foliage:** Smaller leaves
- **Flavor:** Strong flavor with cinnamon overtones
- **Fragrance:** Sweet
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Resistant:** Resist going to seed
- **Attracts:** Butterflies 
- **Uses:** Great in containers, particularly good for over-wintering indoors, border, fragrance garden, stews & hearty dishes
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, including removal of flower stalks, encourages new leaf growth, more branching & discourages flowering.
