Botanical Name: *Ocimum basilicum citriodorum* 'Mrs. Burns'



- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 20 – 24 in.
- **Width:** 12 in.
- **Habit:** Upright
- **Flower:** White
- **Bloom Season:** Heavy bloomer
- **Foliage:** Small, light-green leaves
- **Flavor:** Lemony, zesty flavor
- **Fragrance:** Fresh citrus scent
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Resistant:** Resist going to seed
- **Attracts:** Butterflies, bees  
- **Uses:** Fragrance bouquet, tea, vinegar, jelly, with seafood, salad, sauces, pesto, dressings, soup, potpourri
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, including removal of flower stalks, encourages new leaf growth, more branching & discourages flowering.
