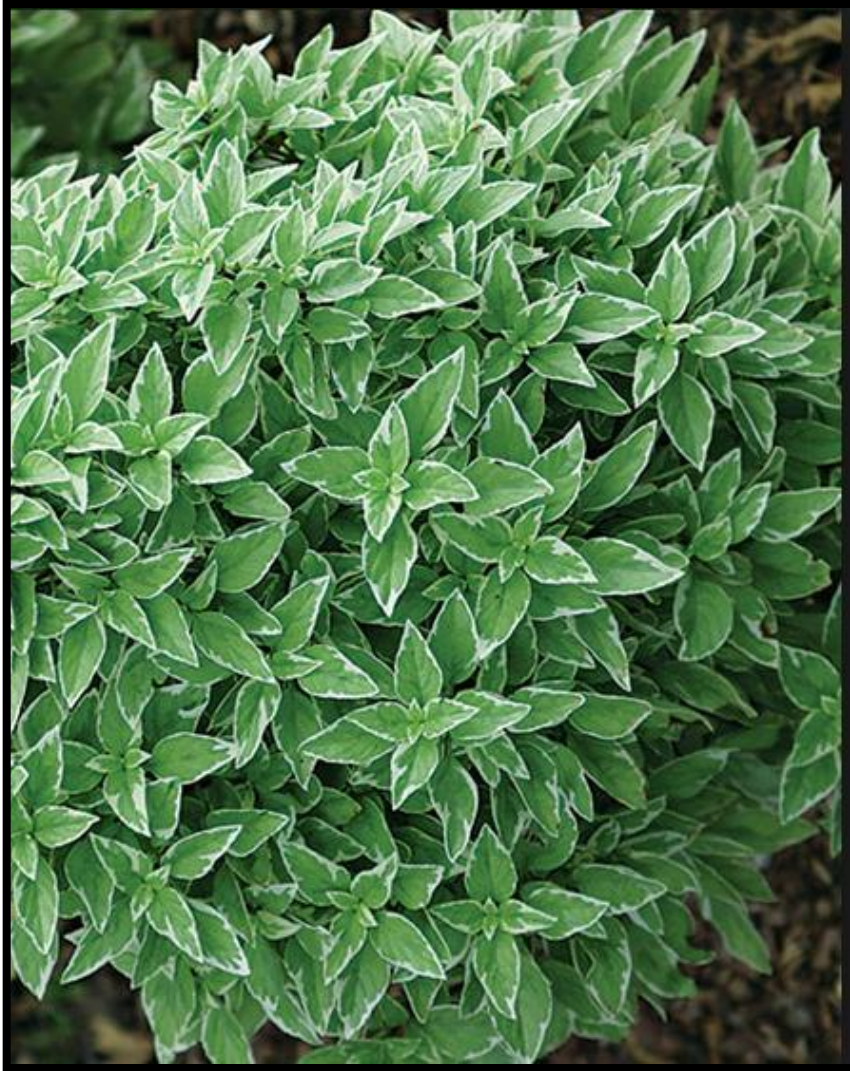



Common Name: Basil, Pesto Perpetuo

- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 18 – 48 in.
- **Width:** 10 – 14 in.
- **Habit:** Columnar
- **Flower:** NA
- **Bloom Season:** NA
- **Foliage:** Beautiful pale green leaves edged in cream
- **Flavor:** Sharp peppery flavor
- **Fragrance:** Floral blend of spice & lemon
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Resistant:** Resist going to seed
- **Attracts:** Butterflies 
- **Uses:** Containers, mixed pots, borders, bouquets, great for wintering over indoors, pesto, sauces, salad, soup, with tomatoes, Italian & Greek dishes, with fish
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, encourages new leaf growth & more branching.
