



Common Name: Basil, Spicy Globe

Botanical Name: *Ocimum basilicum minimum* 'Spicy Globe'



- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 8 – 12 in.
- **Width:** 8 - 12 in.
- **Habit:** Mounding, rounded
- **Flower:** Small, white
- **Bloom Season:** Mid – late summer
- **Foliage:** Tiny leaves & tight, fine-textured form
- **Flavor:** Hearty, spicy
- **Fragrance:** Strong
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Attracts:** Butterflies, bees  
- **Uses:** Border, great in containers, as an edging, cut foliage, fragrance garden, spicier Thai, Greek & Italian dishes
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, including removal of flower stalks, encourages new leaf growth, more branching & discourages flowering.
