



# Common Name: Basil, Sweet Nufar

Botanical Name: *Ocimum basilicum* 'Sweet Nufar'



- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 18 – 24 in.
- **Width:** 12 - 18 in.
- **Habit:** Upright
- **Flower:** White
- **Bloom Season:** Mid – late summer
- **Foliage:** Large, green leaves
- **Flavor:** Classic sweet basil
- **Fragrance:** Sweet
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Attracts:** Butterflies, bees  
- **Uses:** Border, containers, cut foliage, fragrance gardens, salad, sandwiches, Indian, Thai, & Greek cuisine
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, including removal of flower stalks, encourages new leaf growth, more branching & discourages flowering.
