


Common Name: Basil, Sweet Thai

Botanical Name: *Ocimum basilicum* 'Sweet Thai'



- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 12 – 18 in.
- **Width:** 12 – 18 in.
- **Habit:** Mounding
- **Flower:** Purple
- **Bloom Season:** Mid – late summer
- **Foliage:** 2 in. Long, green leaves
- **Flavor:** Spicy anise-clove
- **Fragrance:** Sweet, anise scent
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Resistant:** Resist going to seed
- **Attracts:** Butterflies, bees 
- **Uses:** Containers, cut foliage, fragrance gardens, garnish, bouquets, dried arrangements, hearty soups
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, including removal of flower stalks, encourages new leaf growth, more branching & discourages flowering.
