


Common Name: Basil, Thai Siam Queen

Botanical Name: *Ocimum basilicum* 'Thai Siam Queen'



- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 24 – 30in.
- **Width:** 12 - 18 in.
- **Habit:** Compact
- **Flower:** Purple
- **Bloom Season:** Mid – late summer
- **Foliage:** Tiny leaves & tight, fine-textured form
- **Flavor:** Cinnamon & anise
- **Fragrance:** Rich, without over-powering
- **Sun:** Full to partial shade
- **Soil:** Warm soil with a bit of compost
- **Water:** Average to slightly moist
- **Tolerant:** Deer
- **Attracts:** Butterflies, bees 
- **Uses:** Border, containers, cut foliage, fragrance garden, Thai, Vietnamese & Italian dishes
- **Harvesting:** Frequent pruning, including removal of flower stalks, encourages new leaf growth, more branching & discourages flowering.
