

**Common Name: Tomato, Amish Paste**

**Botanical Name: (*Lycopersicon esculentum*)**



- **Zone:** 10-12, Annual
- **Heirloom** – open pollinated
- **Sets fruit:** 85 days
- **Indeterminate**
- **Sun:** Full
- **Soil:** Rich, moist well drained soil
- **Water:** 1-2 inches per week
- **Habit:** Pole
- **Flower:** Yellow, insignificant
- **Foliage:** Green
- **Fruit:** Red orange, large, plum-shaped
- **Flavor:** Balance of acid & sweetness
- **Uses:** Canning, sauces, salsa, juice, drying, salads, fresh
- **Harvesting:** Pick frequently to increase production
- **Disease:** Susceptible to sunscald & cracking
