

Common Name: Tomato, Arkansas Traveler

Botanical Name: (*Lycopersicon esculentum*)



- **Zone:** 10-12, Annual
- **Heirloom** – open pollinated
- **Sets fruit:** 80-85 days
- **Indeterminate**
- **Sun:** Full
- **Soil:** Rich, moist well drained soil
- **Water:** 1-2 inches per week
- **Habit:** Pole
- **Flower:** Yellow, insignificant
- **Foliage:** Green
- **Fruit:** Rose-colored, smooth, 6-8 oz.
- **Flavor:** Well balanced sweet/tart flavor
- **Uses:** Slicing, sandwiches, salads, fresh
- **Harvesting:** Pick frequently to increase production
- **Disease:** Tolerates heat and humidity, great for MO, crack, blight and disease resistant
