Botanical Name: (*Lycopersicon esculentum*)



- **Zone:** 10-12, Annual
- **Heirloom** – open pollinated
- **Sets fruit:** 75-85 days
- **Indeterminate**
- **Habit:** Pole
- **Flower:** Yellow, insignificant
- **Foliage:** Green, potato leaf
- **Fruit:** Reddish-pink skin & red flesh
Large, flat, beefsteak, deeply lobed
- **Flavor:** Outstanding, rich, tomatoey, sweet flavor
- **Uses:** Fresh, salads, slicing, sandwiches
- **Harvesting:** Pick frequently to increase production.
