

Common Name: Tomato, Cherokee Purple
Botanical Name: (*Lycopersicon esculentum*)



- **Zone:** 10-12, Annual
- **Heirloom** – open pollinated
- **Sets fruit:** 85 days
- **Indeterminate**
- **Habit:** Pole
- **Flower:** Yellow, insignificant
- **Foliage:** Green
- **Fruit:** Purple-skinned, globe shaped fruit. Flesh ranges from purple to green to brick-red.
Flavor: Full acidity and rich, old fashioned, sweet flavor
- **Uses:** Tomato sandwich, fresh, salads, slicing
- **Harvesting:** Pick frequently to increase production.
- **Disease:** None reported
