- **Zone:** 8-11
- **Type:** Tree
- **Height:** 6-10 ft.
- **Width:** 2-4 ft..
- **Habit:** Tall, slender, evergreen
- **Flower:** White
- **Bloom Season:** Rarely flowers
- **Foliage:** Lance-like, yellowish-green leaves up to 7 in. long.
- **Fruit:** Capsule-like fruits
- **Flavor:** Sweet
- **Fragrance:** Lemon
- **Sun:** Full sun
- **Soil:** Well-drained
- **Water:** Medium
- **Tolerant:** Drought
- **Uses:** Container, houseplant, fragrance garden, potpourris. Essential oils are used in perfumes, insect repellants. Boil the leaves for relief of respiratory problems.
- **Harvesting:** Leaves are steam-distilled to produce essential oils. Leaves can be clipped fresh & boiled to provide some relief for respiratory symptoms.
