Botanical Name: (*Lycopersicon esculentum*)



- **Zone:** 10-12, Annual
- **Heirloom** – open pollinated
- **Sets fruit:** 80-85 days
- **Indeterminate**
- **Habit:** Pole
- **Flower:** Yellow, insignificant
- **Foliage:** Green, potato leaf
- **Fruit:** Deep, rich, chocolate red with green shoulders & pear shaped
- **Flavor:** Rich, sweet, deep flavor
- **Uses:** Tomato sandwich, fresh, salads, canning, beautiful sliced out on a dish
- **Harvesting:** Pick frequently to increase production.
- **Disease:** Crack resistant
