

# Common Name: Lavender, Dilly Dilly

Botanical Name: *Lavandula x intermedia* 'Dilly Dilly'



**Zone:** 5 - 9

**Type:** Herbaceous perennial

**Height:** 20 – 24 in.

**Width:** 8 – 12 in.

**Habit:** Mounding

**Flower:** Long spikes of lavender flowers

**Bloom Season:** June - July

**Foliage:** Rough, gray-green

**Fragrance:** Very fragrant

**Sun:** Full sun



**Soil:** Well-drained, sandy-gravelly, alkaline



**Water:** Dry-medium

**Tolerant:** Drought, heat, humidity, wind, deer

**Uses:** Container, herb garden, rock gardens, fragrance garden, borders, potpourris, cut & dried arrangements. Lavender wands.

**Harvesting:** For sachets & potpourris, cut flower spikes or strip flowers from stems just as blossoms show color; dry in a cool, shaded place. Leaves can be stripped & used fresh or dried. Essential oils are extracted via steam distillation.

**Attracts:** Bees, birds, butterflies



**Note:** Mulch with rock, no organic mulches please.
