

**Common Name: Pruden's Purple**

**Botanical Name: (*Lycopersicon esculentum*)**



- **Zone:** 10-12, Annual
- **Heirloom** – open pollinated
- **Sets fruit:** 72 days
- **Indeterminate**
- **Habit:** Pole
- **Flower:** Yellow, insignificant
- **Foliage:** Green, potato leaf
- **Fruit:** Large 1 lb., slightly flattened, pretty, blemish-free, purple-pink fruits  
**Flavor:** Rivals Brandywine as the best-flavored heirloom tomato
- **Uses:** Tomato sandwich, fresh, salads, slicing
- **Harvesting:** Pick frequently to increase production.
- **Disease:** None reported
