

Common Name: Geranium, Scented 'Concolor Lace'

Botanical Name: *Pelargonium 'Concolor Lace'*



Zone: 9

Type: Tender perennial

Height: 12 in.

Habit: Rounded if kept manicured

Flower: bright red.

Bloom Season: May to July

Foliage: light green leaves

Fragrance: sweet-nutty

Sun: Partial shade to shade

Soil: Sandy to loamy well-drained soil

Water: Medium

Garden Uses: Ornamental, fragrance garden, containers

Medicinal Uses: Antibacterial, aromatherapy, astringent, tonic

Over wintering: Keep inside from fall to spring in a cool basement or other similar location. Water them sparingly! Trim the plants back to base in fall (or in spring). This will encourage the plant to grow back nicely.
