

Common Name: Geranium, Scented 'Lemona'

Botanical Name: *Pelargonium crispum*



Zone: 9

Type: Tender perennial

Height: 24 – 30 in.

Habit: Trailing

Flower: delicate rose

Bloom Season: May to July

Foliage: roundish, crinkly leaves on stiff stems

Fragrance: strong lemon

Sun: Partial shade



Soil: Sandy to loamy well-drained soil



Water: Medium

Garden Uses: Ornamental, fragrance garden, containers, hanging basket

Medicinal Uses: Antibacterial, aromatherapy, astringent, tonic

Over wintering: Keep inside from fall to spring in a cool basement or other similar location. Water them sparingly! Trim the plants back to base in fall (or in spring). This will encourage the plant to grow back nicely.
