
## Common Name: Geranium, Scented 'Nutmeg' Botanical Name: *Pelargonium x fragrans*

Soil: Sandy to loamy well-drained soil

**Medicinal Uses:** Antibacterial, aromatherapy, astringent,

**Over wintering:** Keep inside from fall to spring in a cool basement or other similar location. Water them sparingly! Trim the plants back to base in fall (or in spring). This will

encourage the plant to grow back nicely.
