

Common Name: Geranium, Scented 'Orange'

Botanical Name: *Pelargonium citrosum*



Zone: 9

Type: Tender perennial

Height: 24 – 30 in.

Habit: Upright

Flower: Pink

Bloom Season: May to July

Foliage: Medium sized, rounded, bright green leaves have moderately deep veins

Fragrance: Citrusy smelling foliage evocative of an orange grove.

Sun: Partial shade



Soil: Sandy to loamy well-drained soil



Water: Medium

Garden Uses: Ornamental, fragrance garden, containers, hanging basket

Medicinal Uses: Antibacterial, aromatherapy, astringent, tonic

Culinary Uses: The leaves can be used to infuse sugar for cakes and icings, to flavor sorbets and teas.
