


Common Name: Calendula, Flashback Mix (Pot Marigold)

Botanical Name: *Calendula officinalis*




- **Type:** Annual
- **Height:** 18-24 in.
- **Width:** 6-12 in.
- **Habit:** Upright, mounding
- **Flower:** Various shades of 2 ½ in. orange, yellow, off white
- **Bloom Season:** Late spring, early summer of 2nd yr.
- **Foliage:** Each leaf is divided into sub-leaves with serrated edges, stems are hollow.
- **Flavor:** Spicy
- **Fragrance:** Clean, antiseptic
- **Sun:** Morning sun, afternoon shade
- **Soil:** Average
- **Water:** Average
- **Tolerant:** Drought
- **Attracts:** Butterflies 
- **Uses:** Containers, cut flower, insect control. Can be used as an antiseptic, food coloring and mild spice. Flowers are edible, but can be bitter.
- **Harvesting:** Cut flowers when young & use fresh
