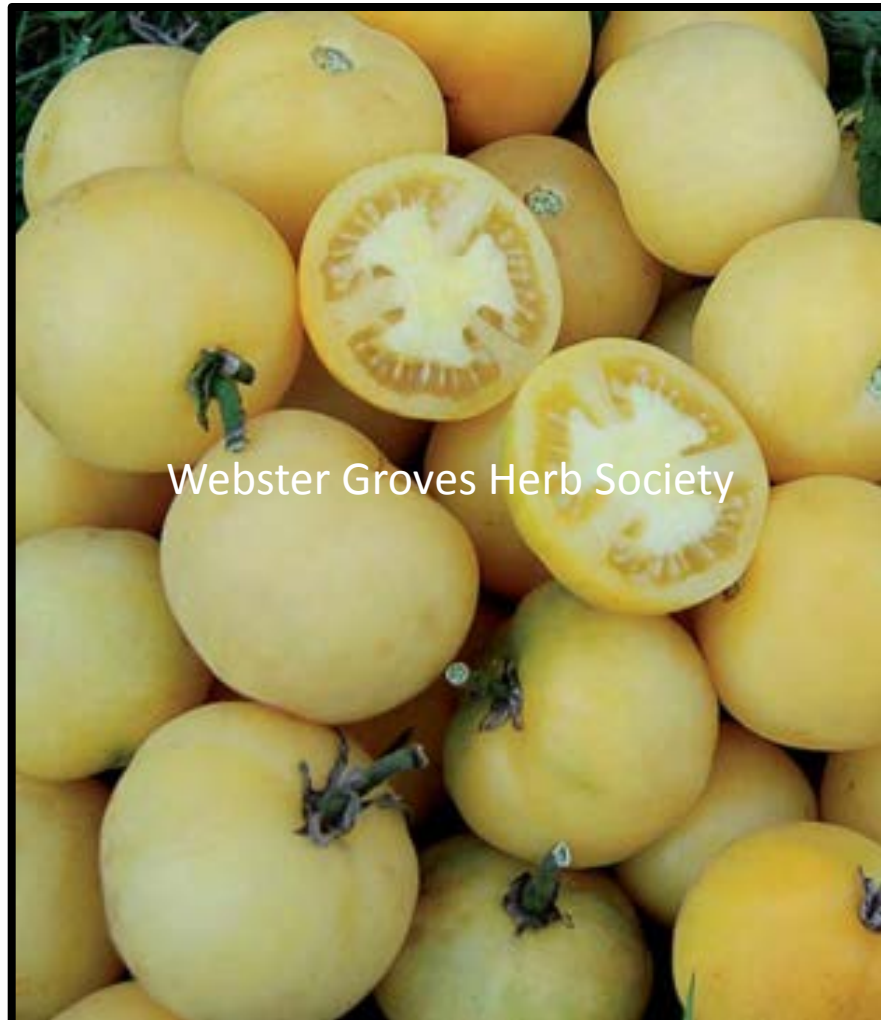


Common Name: Tomato, Medium - Wapsipinicon

Botanical Name: *Lycopersicon esculentum*



Zone: 10-12

Type: Annual

Heirloom – open pollinated

Sets fruit: 80 days

Indeterminate

Habit: Pole

Flower: Yellow, insignificant

Foliage: Green

Fruit: 2 in., fuzzy, pale yellow peach-skin type

Flavor: The taste is complex, with a spicy, sweet, and very fruity flavor

Sun: Full sun



Water: Medium

Soil: average, well-drained garden soils

Uses: Fresh eating, sauce, roasting, canning, freezing

Harvesting: Pick frequently to increase production.

Disease: Rot resistant
